

## Web Parts

My View is made up of many different web parts detailing different patient and result lists. There is no limit as to how many you can have on your view.

### **My Inpatients w/ Recent Results**

Inpatients linked to you who have had results within the past 30 days.

### **My Outpatients w/ Recent Results**

Outpatients linked to you who have had results within past 30 days.

### **New Lab Results**

Critical results are at the top of the list in red. Once you mark result as reviewed, result is removed from list.

### **My Rounds List**

List of inpatients for which you are the attending on record.

### **My Web Space**

Attach any website you want to access within MDAccess.

### **Patient Census**

All hospitalized patients. You can filter by location.

### **ED Census**

All patients by ED Location. You can filter by location.

### **User Built Web Parts**

#### **My Watchlist**

Add patients and editable comments to this list from the Results screen using the ToolBar.

#### **Patient FollowUp Listing**

Add patient to this list for you or your nurse to follow up at later time.

**MDAccess, HML's Physician Portal, is** a Web-based application that allows providers and their key staff members to view their final patient reports from HML quickly, efficiently, and securely anywhere you can access the Internet.

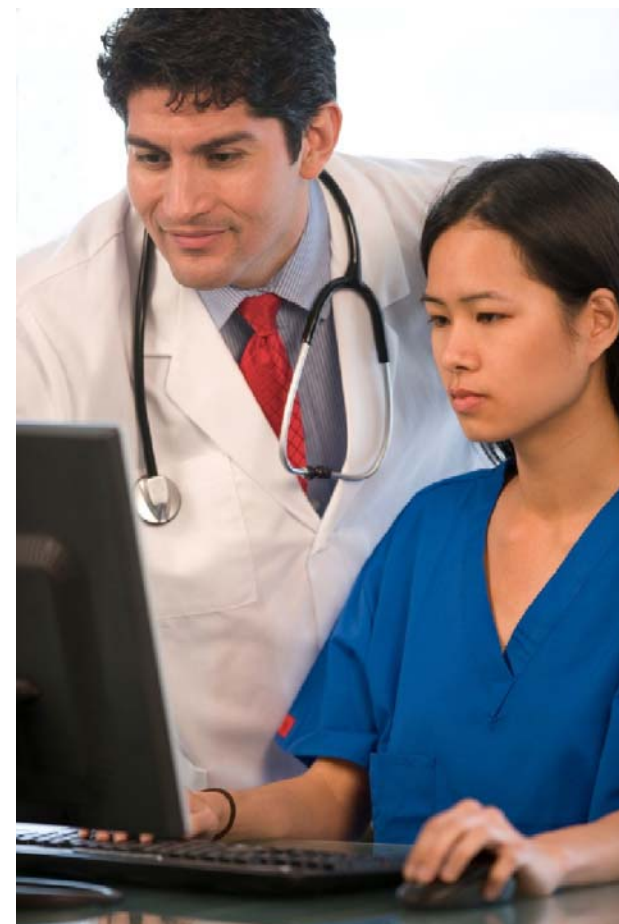

# My View

## Side Bar

1. Indicates where you are in the site and who is logged in.
2. Select to view new results not marked as reviewed.
3. Click + to expand your practice. Select the provider to view associated patients' results.
4. Click My View button to return to this screen.
5. Print a map and directions to your other locations.
6. Access online help.

## Features



- a. Search for patients by last name, first name; medical record number, ; Hospital Visit Number
- b. Enlarge a web part to full screen size
- c. View patient results by clicking on their name
- d. Look for the  in column headings to filter your list
- e. Change your layout (add, remove or move web parts)
- f. Add or Remove columns
- g. Filter by the providers you are linked to
- h. Stretch web parts to the right or left
- i. Remove a patient from your list
  - ⇒ Click on any column header to sort data
  - ⇒ Move columns by clicking and dragging

# Viewing Results

## Viewing Results — key features

- ◇  Add or remove columns for result row or component level
- ◇  Use a select box with the Toolbar buttons when selecting more than one row.
- ◇ Review a lab result by viewing the report in the lower half of the screen, expanding to see components, graphing a result, or viewing a cumulative summary.

## Toolbar Buttons—use while you have a row highlighted or select boxes checked

- ◇ Graph—graph of result with all components
- ◇ Cumulative Summary—chart of results (also see icon in Sum column of result)
- ◇ Review/Followup—to mark as reviewed or to add result to My Followup list
- ◇ Add to Watchlist—add patient with a comment to your Watchlist
- ◇ Visit Info—lists all visit data for the patient
